

WG 4 WORKPLAN 2013- 2014



Priority 1

- Map variety of TAU in different countries:
(lead: Judith Sinzig, Luise Poustka, Erica Salomone)
 - ▣ Part 1: Parent Survey
 - Survey took place in October, Erica is analysing data now, 3 publications planned (access to services / access to education / complementary-alternative treatments)
 - ▣ Part 2: Professionals Survey
 - Was sent out, some countries still missing
- ▣ 2 STSM's took place (UK-Germany)

Priority 2

- Evaluate outcome measures on parent-child interaction (Petra Warreyn & Bernadette Rogé)
 - ▣ Separate pieces of work in France, Belgium, and UK regarding different coding schemes
 - ▣ 2 STSM's happened (Italy → UK / Germany → UK)
 - ▣ Training school planned (June 2013)
 - ▣ WG4 meeting May: main agenda point to integrate this work

Priority 3

- Evaluate possible ways to measure treatment fidelity (Helen McConachie)
 - ▣ Helen continuing systematic review of European studies and RCT's
 - ▣ Publication planned

Priority 4

- Exploring possibilities for sharing data (Iris Oosterling)
 - 4 studies with shared baseline characteristics, outcome measures & 1 year follow-up interval, developing common data format
 - Shared database of 3 studies created
 - STSM planned (Netherlands – UK)
 - Paper in preparation

Planning

 - Training school
 - 1 planned STSM, more to propose (e.g. develop TAU questionnaire based on survey)
